We want our children to look proud of their school. All children are expected to wear full uniform every day.

School uniform

Red polo shirt

Red jumper or cardigan

Grey trousers, skirt or pinafore dress

Black shoes with straps or laces. No trainers.

Should a Hijab be required, it should be either plain red or white. No loose scarves should be worn.

PE Uniform

Plain grey or black jogging trousers, leggings or shorts.

Plain red t-shirt

Red school jumper or cardigan

Plain, dark trainers or black pumps. No white or coloured trainers.

For health and safety reasons the wearing of jewellery is **not permitted** in school.

If children must wear earrings, then only small stud earrings are acceptable, but these must be removed during PE sessions.
