Road Safety

As we near the end of term, we will be talking to the children about staying safe over the summer holidays. In assembly, we will be modelling how to use the **Green Cross Code** to support our children to remember how to cross the road. When you are out and about, please reinforce this essential safeguarding learning.

What is the Green Cross Code?

1. Think! First find the safest place to cross.
2. Stop! Stand on the pavement near the kerb.
3. Use your eyes and ears! Look all around for traffic and listen.
4. Wait until it's safe to cross! If traffic is coming, let it pass.
5. Look and listen! ...
6. Arrive alive!
