FREE Breakfast Club

Breakfast club is **free** for all year groups Reception-Year 6. Please make good use of this provision, it is there to help with punctuality, healthy eating and making new friends.

We are open at 08:00am and provide a healthy breakfast with a selection of juices, breakfast bagels with lots of toppings to choose from, social time with friends playing games, colouring and lots more.

Medication

It is parent's/ guardians responsibility to ensure we have **ALL** medication in school, in date, labelled with your child's name and class.

Parents/ Guardian's must inform school of any medical conditions and bring in medical evidence to support this such as Allergies, ashtma ,eczema etc. If your child need to be given any medication for long, or short-term illnesses such as antibiotics , please speak to the office and we can assist you.

All medical appointments should be arranged outside of school hours where possible, if this is unavoidable, please bring in proof of your appointment in advance and let the office know so we can update your child's record.

Attendance

There are new laws about fixed penalty notices (fines) for unauthorised absences What you need to know.

Penalty notices fines may be issued for term time leave of 5 or more consecutive days

Penalty notice fines will be considered when there have been 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in a 10-week period.







How much could parents and carers have to pay in fines?

First fine

The first time a penalty notice is issued for term-time leave or other unauthorised absence, the amount will be £160 per parent, per child when paid within 28 days.

This is reduced to £80 per parent per child if paid within 21 days.

Second Fine (Within 3 years)

The second time a fixed penalty notice is issued for term-time leave or irregular attendance the amount will be £160 per parent per child when paid within 28 days

Third fine and any further offences (Within 3 years)

A penalty notice will not be issued the case will proceed to the magistrate's court. Magistrates fine can be up to £2500 per parent per child.

If you are planning to take your child out of school, you will need to make a written request to Mrs. Nott, Headteacher before it is taken. Term-time leave is only authorised in exceptional circumstances.
